Responsibilities:

Serving: Our kitchen assistant's primary responsibility is serving meals to guests, ensuring all portions are balanced and meet Hope Faith's guidelines.

Meal Preparation: Assist our chefs with easy food prep tasks such as cracking eggs, peeling produce, etc.

Set-up and Clean-up: Help set up the dining area, maintain cleanliness during meal service, and assist with cleaning dishes and kitchen equipment after service.

Food handling safety: Follow food safety guidelines to prepare and serve all meals safely.

Guest interaction: Treat all guests with respect and kindness.

Team Collaboration: Work closely with kitchen staff and other volunteers to ensure efficient meal service.

Requirements:

- Must be over the age of 12 (ages 12-17 are required to be with a responsible adult)
- Must be able to commit to 1 shift a month for 6 months (at least)

Overview: Hope Faith relies on generous donations to help meet the clothing needs of individuals experiencing homelessness. We are seeking organized and detail-oriented volunteers to assist in sorting donated items and maintaining Hope Faith's clothing closet. Your role will help ensure that our guests have access to clean, appropriate clothing and essential items.

Responsibilities:

Sorting Donations: Sort through incoming donations of clothing, shoes, and accessories to determine their condition and appropriateness for use.

Organizing the Closet(s): Arrange and maintain a well-organized clothing closet by categorizing items by size, gender, and type (shirts, pants, coats, etc.).

Quality Control: Ensure all donated items meet Hope Faith standards by checking for cleanliness, damage, and usability before placing them in the closet.

Guest Assistance: When required, help guests find clothing items that suit their needs while maintaining dignity and respect.

Requirements:

- All volunteers ages 5 - 12 must be accompanied by their legal guardian, and volunteers ages 12 - 17 must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
